Esempio in G: G (Tonica)

- Bb (Terza minore...fa parte della pentatonica)
- B (Terza maggiore...é la terza dell'accordo di G7)
- C (Quarta giusta...fa parte della pentatonica)
- C# (Quarta eccedente...fa parte della penatonica blues)
- D (Quinta giusta...fa parte della pentatonica)
- F (Settima minore...fa parte della pentatonica)
- F# (Settima maggiore...utilizzata spesso come approccio cromatico all'8va)
